Exodus 13-14

Exodus 12:37, *The Israelites journeyed...*

Exodus 12:38, *Many other people went up with them...*

Exodus 13:2, *“Consecrate to me every firstborn male. The first offspring of every womb among the Israelites belongs to me...”*

Are we giving God our first and best or just giving Him whatever is left over?

Exodus 13:3, *Then Moses said to the people, “Commemorate this day, the day you came out of Egypt...”*

Remembering what God has done in the past helps us trust Him with what's ahead.

Exodus 13:17, *When Pharaoh let the people go, God did not lead them on the road through the Philistine country, though that was shorter. For God said, “If they face war, they might change their minds and return to Egypt.”* **18** *So God led the people around by the desert road toward the Red Sea...*

Exodus 13:21, *By day the LORD went ahead of them in a pillar of cloud to guide them on their way and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so that they could travel by day or night.*

Exodus 13:22, *Neither the pillar of cloud by day nor the pillar of fire by night left its place in front of the people.*

God's presence is more important than having all the answers.

Exodus 14:10, ... *They were terrified and cried out to the LORD.*

Fear can make us forget God's faithfulness.

Exodus 14:12, ... *“It would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the desert!”*

Exodus 14:13, ... *“Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the LORD will bring you today...”*

- 2. Stand FIRM**
- 3. See the DELIVERANCE of the Lord**

Exodus 14:14, *“The LORD will fight for you; you need only to be still.”*

Exodus 14:15, ... *“Why are you crying out to me?”*

Exodus 14:15, ... *“Tell the Israelites to move on.”*

Faith often requires us to take a step before we see God provide.

Exodus 14:16, *Raise your staff and stretch out your hand over the sea to divide the water so that the Israelites can go through the sea on dry ground.*

Exodus 14:21, *... the LORD drove the sea back with a strong east wind and turned it into dry land. The waters were divided, **22** and the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left.*

What looks impossible to us is never impossible for God.

The same miracle that delivered God's people also judged their enemies.

Exodus 14:31, *And when the Israelites saw the mighty hand of the LORD displayed against the Egyptians, the people feared the LORD and put their trust in him...*

God's deliverance will always lead us to worship.
