Philippians 2:1-11

Philippians 1:3, I thank my God every time I remember you. **4** In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with **joy 5** because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now,

Philippians 2:5, In your relationships with one another, have the same **mindset** as Christ Jesus:

Why Is True Humility So Important?

1. True Humility Brings HARMONY

Philippians 2:1, Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, **2** then make my **joy** complete by being **like-minded**, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one **mind**.

Ephesians 4:3, Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

Romans 15:5, May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had, **6** so that with one mind and one voice you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2. True Humility Puts Others FIRST

Philippians 2:3, Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in **humility** value others above yourselves, **4** not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the **others**.

Romans 12:10, Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves.

Matthew 23:11, The greatest among you will be your servant. **12** For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.

3. True Humility Reflects the Mind of CHRIST

Philippians 2:5, In your relationships with one another, have the same **mindset** as Christ Jesus: **6** Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; **7** rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. **8** And being found in appearance as a man, he **humbled** himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!

Colossians 2:9, For in Christ all the fullness of the **Deity** lives in **bodily** form, **10** and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. ...

Matthew 20:28, "... the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

John 13:14, Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one

another's feet. **15** I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.

4. True Humility Leads to Your ELEVATION

Philippians 2:9, Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, **10** that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, **11** and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

James 4:10, Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.

1 Peter 5:6, Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time.
